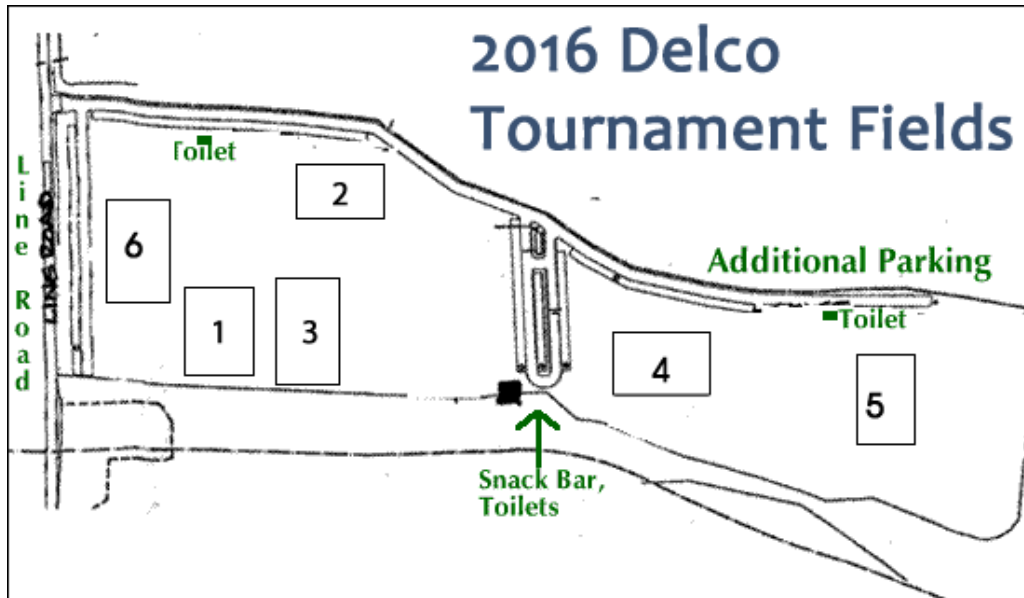




Fields Map & Directions

GCVSA LINE ROAD COMPLEX
137 Line Road, Malvern PA 19355



From Philadelphia: Take I-76 (Schuylkill Expressway) to Route 202 South. Follow Route 202 South to Route 252 South (Paoli exit). Merge onto Route 252 South (a/k/a West Swedesford Road). Go approximately 3 miles (up the hill) to Route 30 (5th traffic light, just under rail overpass). Take a right onto Route 30 West. Travel on Route 30 West for about 1 mile to Paoli Pike (traffic light @ Wawa, Matthews Ford). Veer left onto Paoli Pike ("soft" left). Then follow Paoli Pike approximately 3.6 miles to Line Road, which is just after Bryn Mawr Rehabilitation Hospital on your left. Turn left onto Line Road. Fields are about a tenth of a mile on the left.

From Baltimore, Delaware & Points South (via Route 202): Take I-95 North (past Wilmington) to Route 202 North. Follow Route 202 North into Pennsylvania (past Route 1 & Route 926). Stay on Route 202 North by taking the West Chester Bypass, & follow Route 202 North to Paoli Pike exit. Turn left (heading east) at the end of exit ramp. Then follow Paoli Pike approximately 2.3 miles to Line Road. Note: As you near Line Road, you will cross over Route 352. After crossing Route 352, you will pass East Goshen Park on your left. After passing East Goshen Park, look for Line Road & make a right. Fields are about a tenth of a mile on the left.

PA Turnpike - Eastbound (From Harrisburg & Points West): Take PA Turnpike East to Exit 23 (Downingtown). Take Route 100 South (through Exton) to Route 202 South. Follow 202 South to Paoli Pike exit. Turn left (heading east) at the end of exit ramp. Then follow Paoli Pike approximately 2.3 miles to Line Road. Note: As you near Line Road, you will cross over Route 352. After crossing Route 352, you will pass East Goshen Park on your left. After passing East Goshen Park, look for Line Road & make a right. Fields are about a tenth of a mile on the left.

PA Turnpike - Westbound (From Princeton, Lower Bucks County & Points East): Take PA Turnpike West to Valley Forge (Exit 326, formerly Exit 24). Take Route 202 South to Route 252 South (Paoli exit). Merge onto Route 252 South (a/k/a West Swedesford Road). Go approximately 3 miles (up the hill) to Route 30 (5th traffic light, just under rail overpass). Take a right onto Route 30 West. Travel on Route 30 West for about 1 mile to Paoli Pike (traffic light @ Wawa, Matthews Ford). Veer left onto Paoli Pike ("soft" left). Then follow Paoli Pike approximately 2.3 miles to Line Road, which is just after Bryn Mawr Rehabilitation Hospital on your left. Turn left onto Line Road. Fields are about a tenth mile on the left.

From Delaware County, PA: Take Route 1 or Route 3 to Route 352 North. Follow Route 352 North to Paoli Pike (traffic light). Turn right & proceed 1 mile to Line Road. Note: You will pass East Goshen Park on your left. After passing East Goshen Park, look for Line Road & make a right. Fields are about a tenth of a mile on the left.

Vehicles are to only park in designated parking spots. Once in the Line Road Complex, vehicles absolutely cannot park along the fence on the left side of the complex entrance road.

Teams are welcome to carpool either from their town (recommended) or can meet at a location close to Line Road & then carpool from there. Below are the addresses of four public parking lots within a few minutes of the Line Road Complex:

- East Goshen Township Park 1611 Paoli Pike West Chester, PA
- East Goshen Township Building 1580 Paoli Pike West Chester, PA
- Goshen Village Shopping Center 1508 Paoli Pike West Chester, PA
- East Goshen Elementary School 800 N. Chester Rd. (Rt.352) West Chester, PA

It is strongly suggested that teams participating in the tournament make carpool arrangements, regardless of the site the team is playing at.

At all tournament sites, including the Line Road Complex, spectators should be aware that parking is limited & to park only in designated spots. Vehicles parked in undesignated areas, including emergency vehicle access points, will be ticketed & towed at the owner's expense.

Additional Guidelines:

- Dogs & other animals (except service dogs) are not permitted at any of the tournament sites.
- Smoking is not permitted at any of the tournament sites.
- Barbecue grills & alcoholic beverages are not permitted at any of the tournament sites.
- Teams are responsible for policing of their respective sidelines for trash after each of their games.
